Dear Mr. Gardiner:

We hereby withdraw our shareholder proposal on Internet freedom of expression filed May 12, 2001 on behalf of shareholders Brian Arbogast and Valerie Tarico.

We are withdrawing pursuant to your May 25 communication with the following commitments:

1. RIM will include more discussion of the issues surrounding privacy and human rights in the course of our business in the next Corporate Responsibility Report, scheduled for publication in July, 2011.
2. Senior representatives of RIM will meet in person with you, and other mutually agreed upon parties, in the Fall of 2011 (October to December, inclusive) to further discuss RIM's policy and operating procedure in the areas discussed.
3. Senior representatives of RIM will meet with the Executive Director of GNI for the purpose of learning more about GNI.

We look forward to further dialogue with the company on this important issue.
